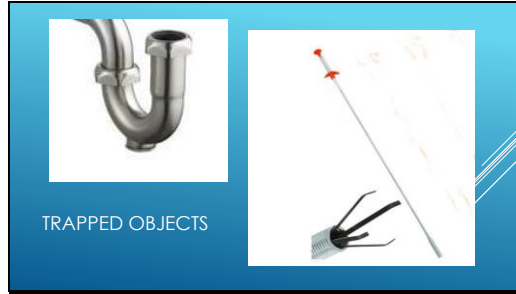
| Problem | Possible fix |
|---------------------------------|--|
| Faucet dripping from spout | Replace worn "O" - ring |
| Leaking from base | R&R with Teflon tape or Replace |
| Hose bib leaking from handle | Repack |
| Spray uneven | R&R aerator Soak in vinegar and replace |
| Kitchen faucet leaking @ handle | Replace "O" rings |
